## **Expiry Check Reference Guide**

## How to Check if a Casual Card is Active

Casual Cards expire after 2 years. It is important that cards are checked to ensure that they have not expired. All cards need to be checked not just a couple. They may have been encoded at different times which will result in different expiry dates.

Casual cards must be placed into the YourPlay green card wallets once encoded. You are required to have 20 available at each service point/cashier, with an additional amount, equal to the number of gaming machines also placed throughout your gaming room

Step 3 - Invalid Card/Card Not Registered



If this error appears, this card needs re-encoding as it has expired. Please remove from the gaming floor, re-encode and ensure you check all of your casual cards

Step 1- Insert Casual Card into Card Reader



**Step 4 - Correctly Encoded Card** 



Insert the casual card into the card reader, the mag stripe on the card must be in the correct position for the card to read

Step 2 - Enter Pin Number of 1111 and Press OK



This is a correctly encoded card, please continue to check the remainder of your cards in the gaming room

Step 5 - Place the Encoded Card in the Green YourPlay Card Wallet
